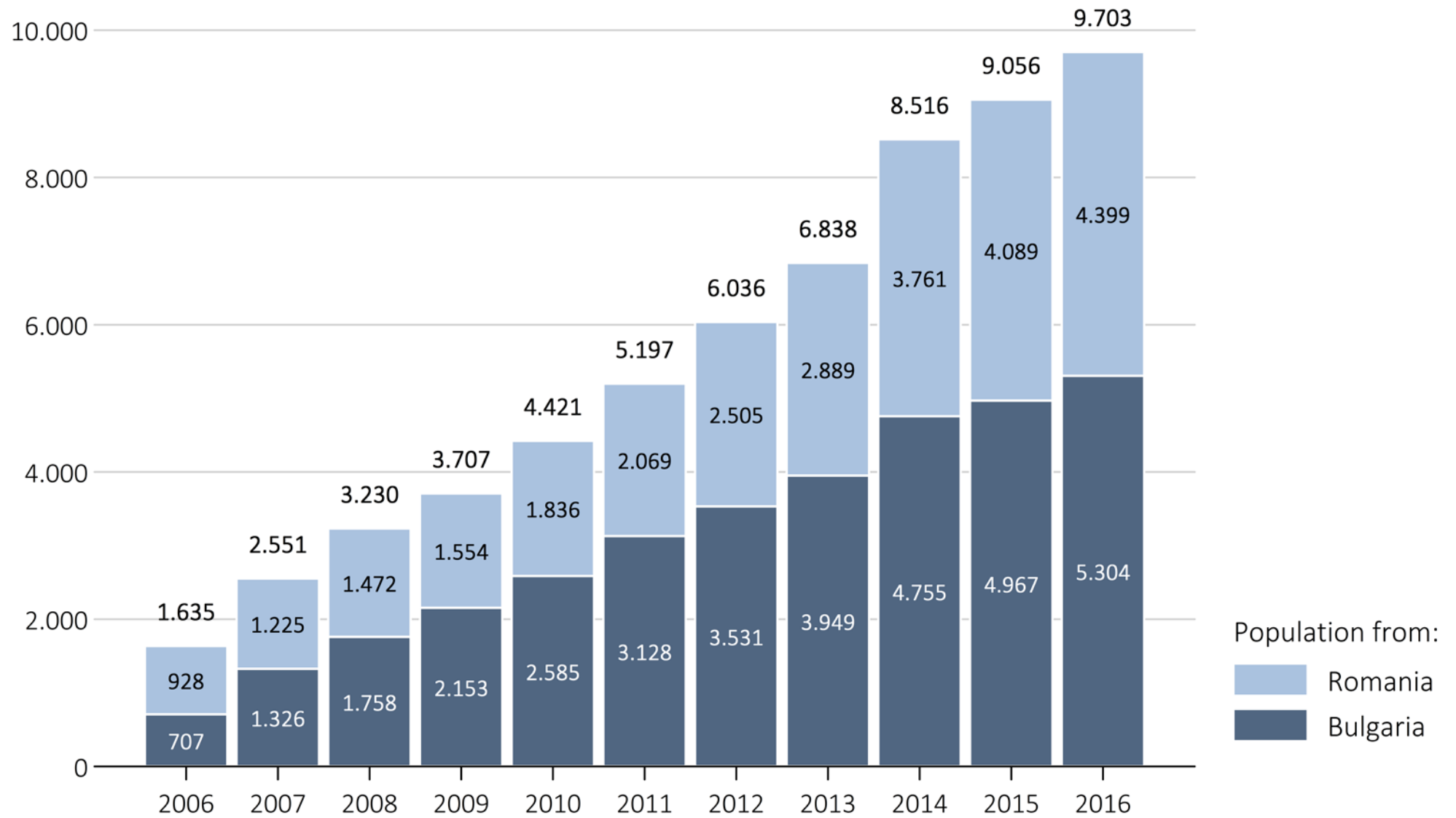

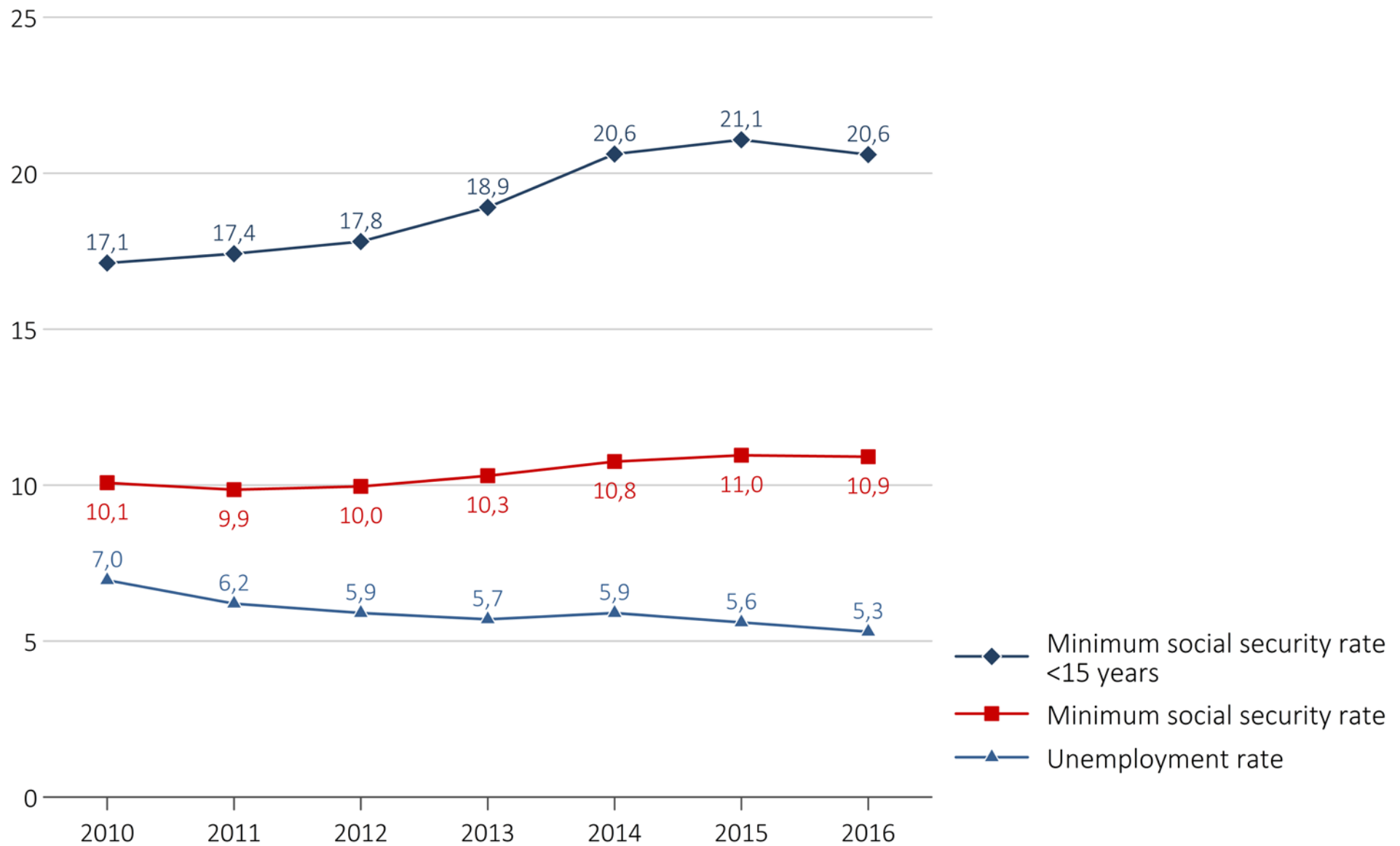

What we talk about when we talk about »**Integration**«

Integration is based on two major components:

- Integration in networks and civil society
- Integration in employment and education

Strategies and activities for both components are required to strengthen social cohesion.

Migration

Strategies for forming a migrant-inclusive urban society:

- Individual and needs-based support and counseling
- Strengthening social cohesion through network building and participation
- Supporting „arrival districts“ with special programs and added resources

Children, Youth and Young Adults

Main strategies for leaving no one behind:

- Empowerment of every child, especially those growing up under difficult circumstances
- Supporting access to labour market (transition school-professional life)

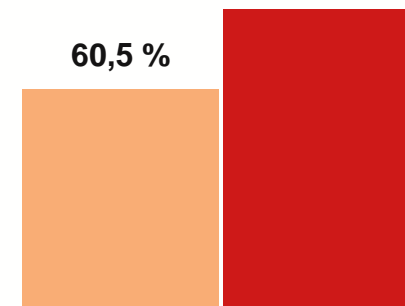
